

Kindergarten Assessment Agreement

District Kindergarten teachers need to assess students within the final month of the Trimesters 2 and 3 reporting periods during the 2020-2021 school year.

Teachers would like to have the option to do in-person testing with their students.

- Teachers will share their testing schedules with site admin in order to maintain appropriate safety protocols as listed in the current MOU
 - In general, there will be two students tested per day *- flexible how many?*
 - If parents opt out of in-person testing, teachers will arrange a mutual time for remote testing.
- Parents will drop students off at a *front office* ~~specified location~~ at the school site and wait in their car during testing. Teachers will meet the student there and escort them to the testing room.
- Teachers, parents, and students will wear masks/face shields at all times while on campus.
 - District will offer tuck-in face shields for teachers who want them
 - Students will also be offered face shields
- District will provide plexiglass partitions to be used between the teacher and the student in the testing room.
- Classified staff will clean the testing room(s) and the designated *- larger plexi glass* Kindergarteners' bathrooms between students.
- This is a non-precedent setting addendum for the 2020-2021 academic year while we remain in distance learning.
